Improvements

Set Default Respondent Tab Filter via Survey Scripting

To support advanced multiple respondent workflows, it is now possible to set the default Respondent tab filter via survey scripting. A new reserved system device variable has been introduced - `__systemRespondentFilter`

An example of setting the filter to only show respondents where background variable 'household' = '2'

```
var filter = {'household': '2'}
SetSurveyDeviceVariable("__systemRespondentFilter", JSON.stringify(filter))
```

CAPI users can manually change the filter at any time through the user interface. The manually set filter will be retained unless the survey device variable is set again during the survey execution.

Camera and Microphone Permission Requests Improvements

Android and iOS devices require users to permit the application to use the camera and microphone before allowing capture of photos/video and audio. If the user declines a permission request, the mobile operating system places restrictions on the application to request permission again in the future.

With the latest CAPI App, the following improvements are included:

Permission Check Dialog

If audio or video permission has been declined by the user and the app attempts to capture audio or video, a new dialog will appear informing the user and providing instructions on how to change the permission under the app settings.

NOTE: changing the audio or video permission under the OS app settings will force an application restart. This will pause the current respondent in progress. When the user returns to CAPI, a new dialog will appear indicating the application was restarted and asks whether they would like to resume the last survey in progress.

Test for Valid Capture

When background audio capture is used, it is now possible to test if the user denied microphone access permission for the app. Use `f('[qid]').get().length` to check for a valid file. If the value is 0, the recording was not started and implies that the user denied permission.

TIP: It is recommended to check this on a separate script node than `startAudioCapture()` as the script will have fully executed before the user is able to answer the permission prompt.

Respondents Tab – Respondent list anchored columns

To assist with identifying a specific respondent row while scrolling horizontally, in addition to the ID column, the first user defined column will also be anchored/frozen while scrolling horizontally.

Note: This only applies to devices with a screen large enough to display 4 or more columns at one time. Smartphone devices or smaller 7" tablets only support 3 columns and continue to only show the ID column as the only anchored column.

This change applies to CAPI for Android and iOS only. It is anticipated that support in Windows will be done in the near future.

New HX Site – US2

The site selection has been updated to support the new HX US2 site

LookupRespondentRecords function change

LookupRespondentRecords() function no longer returns deleted or unassigned respondents.
